Willie D. Smart, 81, of Morris, passed away peacefully Thursday, January 17, 2019 at the Illinois Veterans Home at LaSalle. He was born, November 24, 1937 in Equality, Alabama, the son of the late Luther and Mattie Lou (Bryant) Smart.

Willie graduated from Coosa County High School in Rockford AL with the Class of 1956. He proudly served with the United States Air Force. Willie married Gwen Clark on June 8, 1969 at the Bureau Congregational Church in Bureau, Illinois.
